- 69,788 Items were checked out from the library
- Online databases were accessed 23,529 times.

- 3,878 attended 115 Children's programs
- 347 attended 32 Teen Programs
- 767 attended 109 Adult Programs

- 3,578 People used our computers for 2,588 hours.
- 15,386 wireless users accessed our free WiFi

People



- 32,670 people entered our building
- 1,102 people in 226 groups utilized our meeting rooms
